	competition average)	
	- Scores above 32 will have a 0.2 Handicap reduction per point	
	- Scores below 32 will have a 0.1 Handicap addition per point	
	- Maximum Handicap will be 28	
	- The starting handicaps will be adjusted – up to 17 handicap will receive a 2 shot	
	uplift / 18 to 27 handicaps will receive a 1 shot uplift	
	The system will be monitored and adjusted if proved to be unfair
